- 3. What types of accusations has Paul encountered so far (vv. 5-7; also 16:20-21)? What motivations lie behind these accusations?
- 4. Since his conversion in Acts 9, this is the sixth time Paul had been forced to leave an area because of persecution. How would you feel about your mission if that happened to you? How does your view compare with Paul's view on this (see 1 Thessalonians 2:1-6)?
- 5. Whether Jesus or Caesar was Lord became a real issue for Christians a few years later. When has your faith in Christ led to conflict with other authorities claiming your loyalty?
- 6. When you listen to someone preach or teach do you examine the Scriptures?
- 7. Compared with the Thessalonians (vv2-4), how do the Bereans receive the gospel (vv. 11-12)?
- 8. In terms of time, consistency and intensity, how would you rate your Bible study?
- 9. How might your small group split up to pilot new groups among different folks? What people or task would you be best suited for?
- 10. Based on the passage, what implications are there for us in terms of missions?
