- 3. The Jewish nation expected Jesus to serve as a political king. How do our expectations of Jesus differ from who he actually is in our lives? (Ex: Prozac, Lawyer, Retirement etc.?)
- 4. Can you think of a time when you expected God to work in your life a certain way, and he worked differently?
- 5. Sometimes we are so focused on what is happening around us on earth that we are blinded to the bigger story of God. Has this ever happened in your life? What are some of the things that distract you from the bigger picture?
- 6. If you had lived in Jerusalem during this time, how do you think you would you respond to Jesus' entry? Would you be a follower of Jesus or a skeptic like the some of the Pharisees in the crowd?
- 7. How would you answer if a friend asked you who Jesus was?
